

# **ECDI Fact Sheet: #1 SBA-Micro-lender in the U.S.**

## **ECDI Loan History**

- \$135.8 million disbursed through 6,108 small business loans
- More than 13,200 jobs created and retained
- 28,000+ entrepreneurs assisted through education, loans, technical assistance, Food Fort and Women's Business Centers
- Demographics: 69% minority-owned, 48% women-owned, 18% new American, 45% low to moderate income, 8% veterans

## **Mission Focused**

- Approximately **75%** of businesses receiving PPP funds through ECDI were African American-owned.
- Approximately 41% of businesses receiving PPP funds through ECDI were womenowned.
- Approximately 51% of borrowers receiving PPP funds through ECDI had low to moderate income.
- Approximately 16% of borrowers receiving PPP funds through ECDI were immigrants or refugees.

## **ECDI Making it Happen**

- Less than 20 staff members.
- 104 programming days.
- 19 virtual information sessions with more than 1500 registrants
- Deployment of Women's Business Center for technical assistance to all PPP applicants, many of whom struggle due to the technical divide and/or language barriers.

### **PPP Success by Numbers**

• **\$44 million** in PPP first-draw loan funding disbursed **in four months** (February 2021 - June 2021).



Investing in the growth of small business

- The heavy need from the community required ECDI to bulk up lending systems to achieve more than double the loan funding given since the company's inception in 2004. Prior to the pandemic, ECDI averaged \$7-8 million in loans per year.
- ECDI aided more than **2,000 borrowers and small business owners**.
- \$16.9 million in loans were given out in 2020 at the height of the pandemic (April 2020-Dec. 2020), with more than \$7 million in regular loans disbursed during ECDI's participation in the PPP program.
